



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 31st of Decem^r 1733. ~~day of~~ There was surveyed to their use a certain Tract of Land situate in the Township of Montgomerie in the County of Philadelphia begizing at a hickery being a corner of John Morris's land thence by the same north east four hundred and sixty perches to a White oak thence by a line deviding the County of Buck-from the County of Philad^a North west three hundred and thirty-four perches to a post thence by land late of Ralph Asheton south west four hundred and sixty perches to a post thence by land late of Richard Hayes south east three hundred and thirty-four perches to the place of begining, Containing nine hundred and five Acres with y^e usual Allowance of six th Cent. Surveyed June 11th 1734.
