



A Draught of two Lots of Ground situate in the Town of York on the West side of Codorus Creek and south side of High Street continued containing in Breadth on High Street aforesaid one Hundred & thirty Feet and in length to a twenty feet alley two hundred and Thirty Feet Bounded Northward with High Street aforesaid eastward with Codorus Creek (ob) thward with a twenty feet alley and westward with Vacant low Bottom Ground, surveyed the 16th July 1764. for Jacob Dautel to be holden of the Honourable the Proprietaries at the yearly Rent of Five Pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain &c.
