*At the request of Andreas Rudman That I would grant him five
hundred acres of land on purchase near or adjacent to the new
settlement of the Swedes near Manatawmy now to be made. These are
to require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd for the s^d
Andreas Rudman according to the method of Townships by me ap-
pointed the s^d number of acres of land not already taken up nor conceald
nor seated by the Indians. To be laid out contiguous to the s^d Tract of
the Swedes as also five hundred acres more adjoining to the same
to be disposed of hereafter as I shall see cause and make returns there-
of into my Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand and Seal at
Philad^{ia} the 22^d of 8^{br} 1701.*

*IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
