These are therefore in ye Proprietary's name to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto her ~~the~~ a lott in ye aforesd place where not already taken up, the fence- ing it in & building upon ye same w<sup>th</sup> in six moneths from ye date of survey, and make returns thereof into ye Govern<sup>rs</sup> Secretary's office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 19<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684.
