October ye 20th day 1730.

Surveyed for Roger Kirk of Nottingham in Chester County in the Province of Pennsylvania Weaver a small tract of land being and lying scituate at the North end of a tract of land purchased of James Stapler & C. by the said Roger Kirk being scituate in Nottingham in the County & Province aforesaid beginning at a chestnut stake & at the North East corner of the said tract and running from thence North sixty eight perches y^m 50 82^W. 141 perches y^m South 50 perches y^m East 140 perches to the first beginning containing fifty one acres of land more or less.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty fourth day of March 1910
