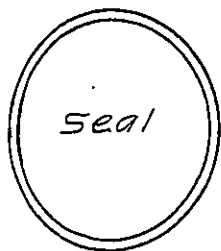


Pennsylvania 55.

These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed the tract of land known by the name of, or called William Penn Jun^r's Mannor adjoining the tract called St. John Fagg's Mannor situate in the County of Chester, the better to fix and ascertain the lines bounds and quantity of the same and make return thereof into our Secretary's office and in so doing this shall be thy sufficient Warr^t.

Given under my hands & the Seal of our Land Office at Philadelphia this tenth day of February Anno Dom. — 1740
