



By virtue of a Warrant to me directed dated ye 7<sup>th</sup> day of  
ye first month 1702.

I have survd unto Cornelius Empson a tract of land in Notting  
ham begining — a corner tree of the Prop<sup>ry</sup> land being a  
hickery thence North 480 pch to a corner black oak thence  
West 163 1/3 — to a corner black oak being a corner of ~~the~~  
another tract of ye Prop<sup>ry</sup> land thence by his line South  
480 pch to a corner white oak then East 163 1/3 pch to the  
place of begining containing 490 acres the 14<sup>th</sup> day of ye  
3<sup>d</sup> month 1702.
