These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed to ye said Jacob Knave according to the method of townships ye sd quantity of two hundred acres of vacant land in the place aforesaid and make returns thereof into ye Secretarys office which survey in case the sd Jacob — fulfill ye above agreement shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our Hand and Seal of ye Province at Philad^{ia} the 15th day of the 12th month A. D. 1717/8
