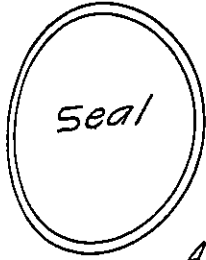


Pensylvania }

These are to require thee to resurvey forthwith to the said Lewis David the said number of one hundred and ninety acres of land laid out as aforesd by vertue of a general Warrt from the Proprietary bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> of the first month 1684 and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this Warrt is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of thy return into his office.
