Also survey and set out to Caleb Pusey tenn acres joining to the Mill at the said Creek for the use of the Mill. Also ninety acres not farr from the said Mill for the said Caleb Pusey that is not taken up there, if so much in the plus land of Upland be left, and make me a true returne of the original field work & protracted figures which are to remain upon record in my office.
