

By order & direction from the Govern<sup>t</sup> & Com<sup>rs</sup> for sett-  
ing out lands to the purchasers in the Province of Pennsilva-  
nia &c I hereby authorize you or any of you to survey and lay  
out unto Griffith Jones the quantity of five hundred acres con-  
tiguous to Samuel Glists lands, up Delaware river, allowing  
twenty pole by the said river side unto each hundred acres,  
and to returne to me an exact duplicate of the originall field  
work & protracted figure which by my pattent are to remain in  
my office dated the 11<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>mo</sup>. 1682.
