


At ye request of Griffith Owen Thomas Duckett William Powell George Wilcox Jonathan Duckett and Isaac Warner that we would grant them to take up a peece of Marsh Cripple and meadow lyieng before Pasayunk on ye west side of the Schuylkill supposed to be abt^{ly} soblxty acres and that each of them may have on equall^{ly} sheir thereof.

These are thereffore in ye Proprietaryes name to will and requir^t thee fforthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto them equally amongst them all (as thay shall hereoblter agree amongst themsalves ffor ye subdivission thereof) obl. afore-said Marsh Meadow and Cripple ~~thay fforthwith ditching and improveing ye same~~ and make returnes thereof into ye Secretary-office dated at Philadelphia ye 7th of January 1692.
