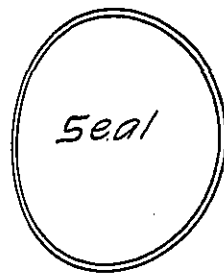

By the Commissioners of Property

At the request of John Shiers first purchaser of one thousand acres of land <sup>in</sup> this Province that we would grant him to take <sup>up</sup> his <sup>proportion</sup> of liberty land belonging to the sd purchase.

These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said John Shiers within the liberties of Philadelphia the quantity of sixteen acres of land on the east side of Schoolkill or on the west side thereof the quantity of twenty acres if either of the said quantities are to be found clear of all other surveys and claims whatsoever and make a return thereof into the Secretarys office in order to a further confirmation.

Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 3<sup>d</sup> day of ye 3<sup>rd</sup> mo. A. D. 1715
