*By the Commissioners of Property*

*At the request of Isaac Self and John Eye of Market Lavington in the County of Wilts in Great Britain by their Attorney Anthony Morris that we would grant them to take up two hundred and fifty acres of land the remainder of five hundred acres purchased of the Prop<sup>r</sup> by Isaac Self Grandfather to ye above said Isaac Self and Edward Eye father of the said John Eye.*

*These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Isaac Self and John Eye in the said Province the said two hundred and fifty acres of land (saving and excepting out of the same the proportion of liberty land to be laid out in the liberties of Philadelphia) that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make returns thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Decemb<sup>r</sup> Anno D<sup>ni</sup> 1719*
