

Pensilvania 5s



By the Commissioners of Property

At the request of James Shattick of the County of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up in the liberties of the City of Philadelphia the proportion of liberty land belonging to the original purchase of five hundred acres of land made of the Propriet^te by Thomas Paget the right whereof being now vested in the said James Shattick and also that a Warrant formerly granted to him for laying out the City lott appurtenant to the said purchase might be executed according to the tenor thereof.

These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said James Shattick within the said liberties the said proportion of liberty land in right of the said purchase and also to execute the said Warrant granted for laying out the said lott of ground in the same right according to the purport thereof and make returnes of the whole into the Secretary's office in order for a further confirmation.
