Upon the Application and Request of Theophila Partridge Sole Executrix of the Last Will and Testament of Thomas Church late of the City of London deceased by her Friend James Logan Esq; That We would be pleased to Grant Our Warrant for Surveying the Quantity of One Thousand five hundred Acres of Land within Our Province, which said Quantity of One Thousand five hundred Acres was by Deeds of Lease and Release of the Third and Fourth days of April Anno; Dom; One Thousand Six hundred and Ninety five Granted by Our late Father William Penn Esq; unto the said Thomas Church his Heirs and Assigns.

These are therefore to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or Cause to be Surveyed according to the Method of Townships Appointed (in One or more Tracts) The said Quantity of One Thousand five hundred Acres of Land, and make Return of the same for the Use of the Heirs of the said Thomas Church into Our Secretary's Office in Order for Confirmation; and in so doing this shall be thy Sufficient Warrant Given under my Hand and the Lesser Seal of Our said Province at Philadelphia this Twenty fifth day of November Anno; Dom; 1737.
