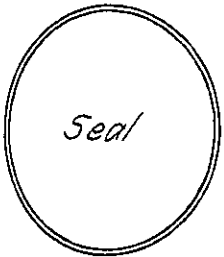


Pennsylvania ss.

At the Request of James Logan of Stenton in the County of Philadelphia That We would Grant him to take up within the County of Bucks the quantity of five hundred Acres of Land in part of the Original purchase of two Thousand Acres made of our late deceased father William Penn Esq<sup>r</sup> by William Lloyd & Abraham Lloyd late of the City of Bristol in Great Britain also deceased by Deeds of Lease & Release bearing date the Sixth & Seventh dayes of February Anno 1681 and since by Several Deeds & Grants is Vested in the s<sup>d</sup> James Logan These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said James Logan in the Township of Solebury in the said County the quantity of five hundred Acres of Land, bounding the Same on the South West with the Lands late of John Scarbrough and <sup>John</sup> Thomas Buy, on the North West with Late Jacob Holcom's, and on the North East and South East with the Land laid out to Robert Heath and make Return thereof into the Secretarys Office Given under our Hands and the lesser Seal of our Said Province at Philadelphia the tenth day of twelfth Month (Feb) Anno D<sup>n</sup> 1732/3
