



Standing by a Run

Beginning at a White oak, being a Corner of James Hendricks Land thence South East by the Land of the sd James Hendricks one hundred & Sixty Six perches to a Small Hickery thence South West by Vacant Land one hundred perches to a White Oak thence South Seventy five degrees Westerly by Vacant Land ~~two~~^{three} hundred and Twenty perches to a Hickery Standing by Conestogoe Creek thence up the same one hundred Ninety & two perches to the Mouth of the Said Run then up the Said Run Two hundred & Thirty one perches to the place of Beginning Containing 250 acres with allowance of Six P.C.

Surveyd October the 20th 1716 pursuant to a Warrant from the Commissioners dated the 22^d of the Sixth month last
