Whereas the Members of y^e free Society of Traders in Pensilvania having purchased Twenty thousand Acres of Land in this Province our late Proprietary & Govern^r W^m Penn Esq^t granted them his Warrant dated y^e Twenty Sixth day of y^e twelfth Month 1682 directed to y^e then Survey^r Gen^l requiring him to Cause y^e same to be Survey'd or laid out to y^e sd Society By Vertue whereof some part of y^e sd Land was Survey'd and y^e residue remains Unlocated,

Now for as much as by an act. of Gen^l Assembly of this Province All the sd Lands with the Appurtenances are Vested and Settled in us as Trustees with Power to Sell the same for y^e Use and Benefit of y^e sd Society In Pursuance of which Trust we have by Vertue of y^e sd Act Sold to John Jones ffour Hundred acres of the sd unlocated Land. Therefore we do hereby Impower & require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the sd John Jones ~~Butter~~ the full quantity of ffour hundred acres of the sd Land not yet Located or Survey'd & make return of y^e Survey thereof and Duly enter y^e same in y^e Survey^r Gen^l's office at Philadelphia And for so doing this and the sd Act of assembly shall bethy sufficient Warrant Given under our hands and seals this fourth day of April one thousand seven hundred & twenty four
