



By ye Commission^{rs} impowerd to grant Lotts & Lands in ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging -

Whereas Nicholas Moore former President of ye free Society of Traders, hath obtain'd of ye Proprietary & Govern^{rs} a Warrant bearing Date ye 26th of ye 12th Mo 1682 to take up their Purchase of Land being Twenty Thousand Acres: And since it was agreed, yt one fourth should be survey'd in ye county of Philadelphia: These are in ye Proprietary's Name to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto them ye sd number of Acres in ye aforementioned County where not already taken up, they seating & improving ye same wth in six Months from ye Date of Survey, according to Regulation & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 15th 9th Mo 1684
