These are to Authorize and Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyed unto the said Casper Wister according to the first lines and bounds the said Tract of Land and make exact Returne thereof into the Secretarys Office in order for further Confirmation for which this shall be thy sufficient Warrant Given under my hand and the lesser Seal of our Province at Philadelphia the 25<sup>th</sup> day of y<sup>e</sup> sixth Mo<sup>th</sup> (Aug<sup>st</sup>) A.D. 1733.
