



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Eighth day of January 1733. Requiring the Surveyor General to Survey or Cause to be Surveyed to Casper Wister Two small Parcels of Land in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. There was Surveyed to the said Casper Wister on the third day of April 1734 one of the said Parcels of Land Situate in the Township of Salford Beginning at a Corner post of Jacob Reiff's land thence by the same South East one hundred and Twelve perches to a post thence by Land Laid out for William Pitts North East thirty Eight perches to a post thence by other Land of the said Casper Wister North West one hundred and Twelve perches to a post thence by Land of Gabreil Shooker South West Thirty Eight perches to the place of Beginning Containing Twenty five acres with the Usual Allowance of Six p Cent
