



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries bearing Date the 25th day of August Anno 1733 there was Resurveyed for Casper Wister of Philadelphia a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Shippack in the County of Philadelphia first laid out to Griffith Jones Beginning at a Corner post of John Lukin's Land Thence by land of Gatchlick & Vacant North West three hundred eighty four perches Then by the Lands of Gabriel Shouler John Johnson Conrad Custer and James Steel North East four hundred ninety two pches to a post Then by the lands of James Dickinson & Thomas Wilson South East three hundred eighty four perches to a post Then by the said John Lukin's Land South West four hundred ninety two pches to the place of beginning Containing One thousand and seventy three acres ~~and seventy three acres~~ besides the Allowance of ten acres p Cent for Roads and High Ways

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Sixteenth day of November 1910,
