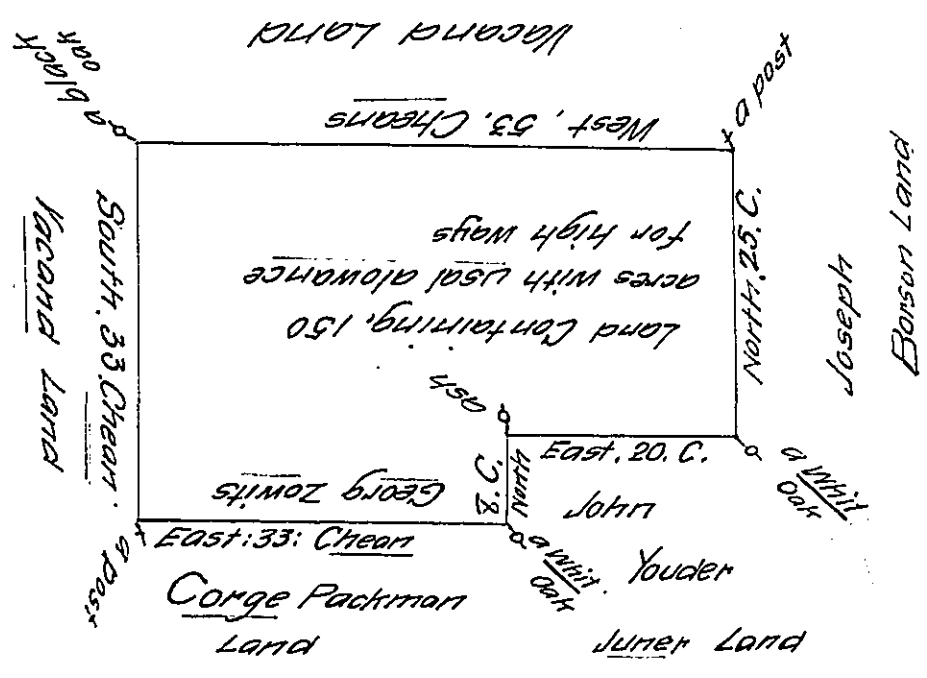

Surveyed Thiss Tract of Land to George Zewits in Right and by order of Caspar Wistar by vartue of an order from Jacob Taylor to me directed bering date July the 3: 1731 Begining at a Whit Oak being the Corner of Gorge packmans Land then Roneth north Eight Cheans to an Ash standing by a brook Caled Socunk then East twenty Cheans by John youders Land to an other Whit Oak then north twenty five Cheans by Joseph Borsons Land to a post then west fifty thre Cheans by Vacand Land to a black oak then south thirty three Cheans by vacand Land to a post standing in gorge packmans line then East thirty thre Cheans to the place of Begining Containing one hundred and fift acres with the usal allowance for Roads. Surveyed the 6 day of the 6 month Caled August in 1731 — By \_\_\_\_\_ John Chapman
