



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 16th Day of December, 1763 and surveyed the 9th, 10th & 11th of June, 1777 to the Honorable the Proprietaries (in part of their tenth.) the above described tract of Land situate on the most westerly branches of Tamaque or little Schuylkill about twenty miles from Groblattenhutzen in Northampton County, Containing Three thousand six hundred and three Acres and the allowance of $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. & c^a.
