



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 16th day of December, 1763 and Surveyed the 12th & 13th days of November, 1776 to the Honorable the Proprietaries (in part of their tenth) the above four described tracts of Land situate on the Branches of the East Branch of Lechawaxsin Creek Called "Sandy Run," about ten miles from Delaware River in Northampton County. Containing together in the four tracts Twelve Hundred and Eighty Acres, forty five perches and the allowance of Six Cent. & C^a Geo. Palmer, D.S.
