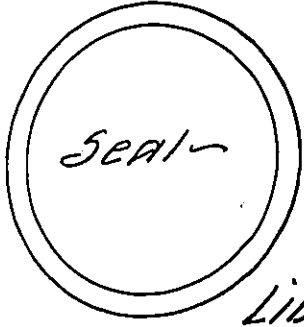


Pennsylvania S. S.

By the Commissioners of Property.



At the Request of James Steel that we would Grant him to take up the proportions of Liberty Land belonging to the Original purchases of five hundred acres made of the Proprietr. by John Martin now of Middletown in Chester County and of two hundred & fifty acres made by Edmund Lovet of Bucks county and also four acres remaining untaken up of Henry Childs Purchase the whole being now vested in the said James. These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey & lay out or cause to be Survey'd & laid out within the Liberties of Philadela. unto the said James Steel the several proportions or parcels of Liberty Land where Vacant and not already Survey'd and make Returns of the whole into the Secretarys Office in order for a further Confirmation. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of the Second Month Anno Dni 1718.
