



By virtue of a warrant from The Commissioner of Property bearing date The day of -- 1725 Resurveyed and fixed the bounds of a Tract of Land for James Steel in Right of Darby Green who purchased The Same of Thomas Zachray Situate in Limerick in The County of Philadelphia beginning at a white oak being a Corner of Jno. Mendals land Thence by The Same North East five hundred and Twelve perches to a post. Thence by land of -- Creven South East one hundred and Sixty perches perches to a white oak being a Corner of Joseph Pikes Land Thence by The Same South West five hundred & Twelve perches To a white oak being also a Corner of Said Pikes land Thence North West One hundred and Sixty perches To the place of beginning Containing five hundred and Twelve Acres Surveyed June ye 19th 1725 p. Nicholas Scull.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of December 1910
