Whereas the former Proprietary Commiss^{rs} did Grant and Sell unto Hugh Roberts two hundred Acres of Land, of which one hundred was for the use of Katherine Thomas who thereupon obtained a Warr^t from the s^d Commiss^{rs} for the same to be laid out in the Welch Tract or elsewhere which Warr^t having never hitherto been executed These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey and lay out to Thomas Jones and Cadwallader Jones Sons & Exec^{rs} of the last Will of the s^d Katherine the said quantity of One hundred Acres of Land in the Welch Tract if there conveniently to be found not yet entered on, or elsewhere where not already Survey'd nor taken up nor concealed nor Seated by the Indians, and make Returns into the Gen^l Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Province Seal at Philad^{ia} 23 - 12^{mo} 1702.
