



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the twenty eighth day of August 1719 There was Surveyed to James Steel in Right of Humphrey Murrey and John Budd a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Salford in the County of Philada. Begining at a white Oak being a corner of a Tract of Land belonging to John Ledrah thence by Land of Jacob Colb South west forty two perches to a post. Thence by Bebbers Township North west Two hundred and two perches to a post thence by Land late of Rees Williams. North East forty two perches to a post thence by Land of sd. John Ledrah. South East Two hundred and two perches to the place of Begining Containing Fifty Acres with the usual Allowance of Six p. Cent.

Surveyed the 13th day of May 1727.

Sold to Martin Holb.

Nicho. Scull.

The figure H is a Draught of 20 a.s. of Land surveyed to Nicho. Scull on the 29th of March 1728. In part of 500 a. granted to him by warrant dated 5th of October 1727 [in lieu of 500 a.s. formerly confirmed to Hannah Price which is found to lie with having relinquished of survey her in the German Tract whose right Nicho. Scull purchased] whch. 20 a.s. N.S. sold to Martin Holb who also having purchased the above of James Steel both returned into the Secretary's Office within one description on the 18th of May 1737. containing 70 acres & a small Allow for Roads.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty second day of December, 1910.
