

I William Penn Proprietary and Governour of the province of Pennsylvania in America Doe hereby [at the request of Tobias Jollett Mishael Russell Daniel Quare & Henry Gouldney] authorise & direct Thomas ffairman or any other person the sd. Tobias Jollett Mishael Russell Daniel Quare and Henry Gouldney shall appoint to survey & take up for them fifteen thousand acres of land in my said province and Territorys thereof withall Lotts, priviledges and Appurtenses to the same belonging part of sixty thousand acres which (amongst other things) were granted and souveyed by me unto the said Tobias Jollett Mishael Russell Daniel Quares Henry Gouldney & their heires by Indentures of Lease & Release bearing date the eleventh & twelfth days of this Instant August And to make returnes thereof into the Surveyor Generalls Office of my said province that the same may from thense be rectified into my Secretarys Office my sd. Surveyor being paid his Office fees & for surveying the sd. Lands according to such Agreement. as he can or shall make with the sd. Thomas ffairman or any other Agent. of the sd. Tobias Jollet and the rest provided always that if the sd. Land should be surveyed or taken up without giving timely & reasonable notice to my said Surveyor Generall some time before the Surveying or taking up thereof that he or his Agent may be present att such Survey That then this my warrant or what shall be done or acted by vertue hereof shall be void and of none effect.
