



By Vertue of a Warrant from the Proprietarie to me directed bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1699. Surveyed and laied unto Tobias Collett Michael Russel Daniel Quaire post of Henry Goldney Seven Thousand five hundred Acres on delaware River within the County of Bucks Beginning a white oak on Delaware Thence by Vac. Land south west one Thousand Six hundred and sixty perches to a black oak for a Corner Thence by Land layed out to the proprietary South East 634 perches to a post being a Corner of John Streper's Land Thence by the said Streper's Land North East one thousand one hundred and sixty perch to a white oak marked for a Corner Thence againe by the said streper's Land South East six hundred and Eighty perches to a black oak sap. standing by Delaware River Thence up the severall Courses thereof unto the first mentioned white oak tree marked for a Corner. p. Tho. Fairman Survr.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twentieth day of January 1911
