*At the request of John ffalconar of London by his Brother Gilbert ffalconar and Andrew Hamilton that we would grant them to take up sixty acres of land within the Liberties of Philadelphia in right of Charles Marshalls purchase of six thousand acres in this Province (being the remainder untaken up of the whole purchase) whose right the said John ffalconar & Andrew Hamilton have lately purchased.*

*These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said John ffalconar & Andrew Hamilton within the aforesaid Liberties or in any other part of the said Province the said quantity of sixty acres of land that is clear of all other surveys and lawfull claims of any person or persons and make a return thereof into the Secretarys office.*

*Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the first month Anno Dni 1715.*
