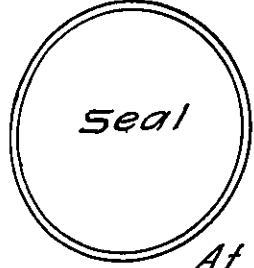

By the Commissioners of Property

fifteen *At the request of Thomas Shute of the County of Philad^a that we grant him to take up within the Liberties of the City Philada the proportions of land belonging to the original purchases of five hundred acres made of the Propriet^r by Ann Ollif of Oxon in Great Britain and of two hundred & ffifty acres made of the Prop^r by Richard Joyrdain of London the right to both the said proportions being now vested in the said Thomas ———*

These are to authorize and require thee to survey & lay out or cause to be survey'd & laid out in the said Liberties in right of the said purchases (if there to be found vac^t) the proportions of land being in ye whole twelve acres on the East side of Schuylkill or fifteen acres if on ye other side of that river and make returns thereof into the Secretary's office.

Given under our hands and the Seal of the the Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of the 3^d month Anno Dni 1718.
