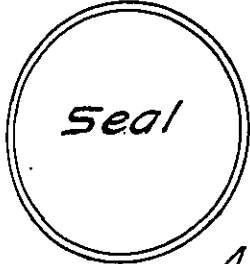


Pensilvania 5s.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Thomas Shute of the County of Philadelphia that we would grant ~~to be~~ to be laid out within the Liberties of the City of Philad^a the proportion of Liberty land appurtenant to ffifteen hundred acres the original purchase of Samuel ffox of Rochester in Great Britain made of the Proprietary by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 24th & 25th dayes of the month called January ANNO — 1681.

These are to authorize and require thee to survey and lay out or cause to be surveyed and laid out in right of the afore-said purchase of ffifteen hundred acres, in the said Liberties (if there to be found vacant) the proportion of land appurtenant to ye same that has not been already survey'd nor appropriated and make returns thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation.
