

Whereas the Commissioners of Property by their Warrant dated the 10th day of January 1721 granted to John Daviobl twenty acres of land to be laid out in the Liberties of Philad^a in right of William Kents purchase of 1250 acres the right ^{to} which twenty acres is now ~~is~~ invested ~~in~~ Isaac Norris Esq^r and whereas ~~that the~~ the said Commissioners by their Warrant dated the 30th day of July 1712 granted to the said Isaac Norris ten acres of Liberty land in right of William Lovel which (with the above twenty ~~acres~~) making thirty acres.

There was survey'd in part thereof on the 20th day of October 1727 a piece of land in the said Liberties beginning at a corn^r of Edw^d Horn's land & running by ye same North N. West one hund^d & seventy perches to a post then W. S. W. twenty ffive perches to a post then S. S. E. by ye land of Thomas Shute and other land obl. hund^d & seventy perches to a post then E. N. E. obliterated ffive perches to ye place - begining containing obl. six acres
