By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of William Allen of the City of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up within the said City the Lot of Ground and within the Liberties thereof the Liberty Land appurtenant & belonging to five hundred acres the original Purchase made of the Late Proprietor by William Clarke of Westminster, the Right whereof being now vested in the said William Allen. These we do Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Will^m Allen within the said City the Lot of Ground and within the Liberties thereof the Liberty Land in proportion to the said purchase and make returns thereof into the Secretary's Office. Given under Our Hands and the Lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 10th day of September Anno Dⁿⁱ. 1730.
