



By Vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietrs. dated the 7th of Augt. 1739. The above described Tract situate on a branch of Brandywine in Chester County was surveyed on the 21st of the same Month unto James Steel in right & in part of dno. Ap. Johns' & Tho. Wynne's original purchase of 5000 A. and is found to contain 194 A & ye Allow. of 6 A. p Cent for Roads &c. Return'd into the Secretrys. Office ye 1st. of May 1735.
