Ratifying and confirming and by these presents allowing whatsoever my said Attorney shall do in my Name lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the premises by Virtue of these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven.
