Donation Land

Whereas the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by Patent, bearing date the eighth day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred & two, granted unto John Kinkead, private in the late army of the United States, Pennsylvania line, a certain tract of land, situated in Donation district No 2, No 297, containing two hundred acres and allowance of six per cent &c, which tract lies within the easternmost part of the second Donation district— And the said John Kinkead by his assignment on the back of said Patent, for the consideration therein mentioned, sold & transferred the same, unto Isaac Craig of Pittsburg in the County of Allegheny.

And Whereas by an act of the General Assembly of Pennsylvania, entitled "An Act regulating and continuing the distribution of Donation Lands" it is provided that "on the application of any person holding donation lands by patent, within the bounds aforesaid, or within that part usually called the Triangle, and the applicant or applicants aforesaid, releasing his her or their Patent or Patents to the Commonwealth, shall have another unappropriated lot or lots of equal quantity.

Now be it known, that in order to obtain the benefit of the said act, and in conformity to the provisions thereof, I the said Isaac Craig do release, remise & forever quit claim for me & my heirs or representatives, all my title and interest as above recited, (together with the
