 Grant Bargain Sell Assign away confirm unto Richard Ludom all my  
 Right Title and property in and to a certain Tract of Donation Lands  
 Granted to me by the said State situate in the Third District of the do-  
 nation Lands thereof and in the County of Westmoreland in the State aforesaid  
 containing Two hundred Acres and Allawamunga To hold to him  
 the said Richard Ludom the said Tract of Lands with the Appur-  
 tenances and to the only proper use and Benefit of the said Richard  
 Ludom his Heirs and Assigns forever - In Witness whereof I the  
 said James Craig have to these presents set my hand and seal  
 this fourth Day April Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred  
 and eighty seven -
