

Know all men by these Presents that I George Crowl
of Strabane Township York County and State of Pennsylvania
have made, ordained, and Constituted, and by these Presents do
make, Ordain and Constitute, and in my Head, Trust and Depute
my Trusty Friend William Walker, of ~~the~~ Tyrone Township
County and State aforesaid, my true and Lawfull Attorney for
me, and in my name, and for my use, to ask, Demand, sue for
Recover, and Receive all such sums, and sums, of Money, which are
or shall be due, owing, Payable, or Detained from me, for services
Done by me as a Militia Man, During the late War with Great
Britain, in whose Hands soever the same may be found.

Giving and Granting unto my said Attorney, by these Presents, my full
and Whole Power, Strength and Authority, and about the Premises,
to have, use and take all Lawfull ways and means, in my Name,
for the Purpose aforesaid, and upon the Receipt of any such sum,
or sums of Money, Acquittances, or sufficient Discharges, for me, and
in my name, to make, seal and Deliver, And Generally, all and
every other act or acts, thing and things, Device and Devices, in the
Law whatsoever, Needfull and Necessary to be done in and about the
Premises, for me, and in my name, to do, Execute, Perform, as fully,
and Largely and amply, to all Intents and Purposes, as I myself
might (or could do) if Personaly Present, and Attornies one or more
under him, for the Purpose aforesaid, to make and Constitute,
And again at Pleasure to Revoke. Hereby Ratifying, allowing,
and Holding for firm and Effectual, all and whatsoever my said
Attorney shall Lawfully do in and about the Premises, by virtue hereof.
