Miller in whose Fidelity in this Behalf, I very much confide, full
Power by the Tenor of these Presents, to administer the Goods, Chattels, Rights
and Credits which were of the said Deceased, within the said County; and also
to ask, collect, levy, recover and receive the Credits whatsoever of the said De-
ceased, which, at the Time of his Death, were owing or to him in any Ways
belong, and to pay the Debts in which the said Deceased stood obliged, so far
forth, as the Goods, Chattels, Rights and Credits will extend, according to their
Rate and Order of Law, especially of well and truly administering the Goods,
Rights and Credits of the said Deceased, and making a true and perfect Inven-
tory thereof, and exhibiting the same into the Register's Office, at the Town of
READING, in the County of BERKS, at or before the *twenty eighth* Day of

May - next, and rendering a true and just Account, Calculation or
Reckoning of the said Administration, at or before the *twenty eighth* Day of
April in the Year of our LORD, *One Thousand, seven Hundred
and Ninety three* And also, I do by these Presents, ordain, constitute and
appoint you the said *Jacob Miller* Administrat

of all and singular the Goods, Chattels, Rights and Credits which were of the
said Deceased, within the Limits aforesaid, saving harmless, and for Ever in-
demnifying me and all other Officers, against all Persons whatsoever, by Reason
of your Administration aforesaid, and saving to all others their Rights. IN
