I do hereby assign all my right title and interest  
of the Two Hundred Acres of Land due to me from the  
State of Pennsylvania for my services as a Soldier in  
the Pennsylvania Line to Alexander Fowler he having paid  
me a valuable consideration for the same, and I do  
hereby empower the said Alexander Fowler to receive  
my said Demand for the said Two Hundred Acres  
of Land from the respective Officers, or Officers  
appointed by the State to give the same.
