

I Edward Edgerton of Wilkesbarre in the county of Luzerne labourer, and lately a soldier in Capt. Thomas Robinson's company of Rangers, appoint Timothy Pickering of Philadelphia esquire my attorney, to apply for and receive the arrears of pay due to me as a soldier in the seventh regiment of the Pennsylvania line, as arranged before the discharge of those troops at Trenton in 1781 - also to receive the patent for the bounty land granted by the State of Pennsylvania, and which I am entitled to. I also empower him to receive the patent for the bounty land due to David W. Cartney late a soldier in Capt. Robinson's company of Rangers, and which said Mr. Cartney gave me an order to receive for him: the patents to be made out in Mr. Cartney's name and mine respectively. Witness my hand & seal the 4th day of May 1787.
