 and in my Name and to my Use to ask demand recover  
 or receive of and from the Honourable the Executive -  
 Council of the State of Pennsylvania - or any ~~the~~ other  
 person or persons by them appointed or by the Honour  
 -able the Continental Congress - the Lands Due me Giving  
 and by these presents Granting to my said Attorney - my sole  
 and full Power and authority to take pursue and follow -  
 such legal Course for the recovery receiving and Obtain  
 -ing of the same as I myself might or could do, were I per  
 -sonally present and Upon the receipt of the same Acqu  
 -tances and other sufficient Discharges for me and in  
 my Name to make sign Seal and deliver - touching  
 and Concerning the premises as fully thoroughly and  
 Entirely as I the said Timothy Flood in my own person  
 ought or could do in and about the same - Ratifying  
 allowing and confirming whatsoever my said attorney  
 shall Lawfully do or cause to be done in and about  
 the Execution of the premises by Virtue of these presents  
 in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
 Seal the twentieth Day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1781
