vania line, Have Constituted made & Appointed, and  
by these presents do make constitute & Appoint  
my trusty friend James O'Hara my true & lawful  
Attorney, for me and in my Name & Stead, and for my  
Use to Ask, Demand & Receive, all Demands due to me  
by the State of Pennsylvania, for Land due for my Service  
as Soldier in the said line during the War, giving and grant-  
ing unto my said attorney, full powers & Authority, upon  
due Acquittances, to give in my Name such Receipts as shall  
be necessary about the premises, to all intents and purposes  
as if I was personally present. In Witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my Hand & Seal the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of Jan<sup>r</sup> 1787
