due and Payable unto me as Corporal in the 1st Pennsylvania
Regiment, and upon the receipt of said Sums or any part
thereof Acquittances for me and in my Name to make seal
and deliver, and also to do, perform and Execute all and
every other Lawful and reasonable Acts & Things, for the obtain-
ing and releasing of the same, as shall be needful and
Necessary to be done. Giving and by these presents granting
unto my said Attorney my full and absolute Power in
the Premises and ratifying and holding firm all and
Whatsoever my said Attorney shall Lawfully do or cause
to be done in and about the Premises by Virtue of these
