

Know all Men By these Presents, That I William Helmer late a Soldier in the 2^d Pennsylvania Regiment

in the service of the United States of America, for value and the full consideration money, to me in hand paid, at, and before the execution hereof by Henry Whipple the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. HAVE, and hereby Do grant, bargain, sell, transfer, convey and confirm unto Henry Whipple his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns for ever, all the right, title and interest whatsoever, in law and equity, which I now have, or which I may - heirs, executors, or administrators, may hereafter have, to the lands, pay, depreciation, clothing, rations, rewards, bounties, gratuities, prize-moneys, and every other advantage claim and demand whatever, due and owing from the United States or any particular state: and I do hereby for myself my heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree, to and with the said Henry Whipple his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns that they heirs, executors, and administrators, will at any time hereafter, at the reasonable cost and charges of Henry Whipple aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assurances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make, constitute and appoint Henry Whipple my true and lawful attorney, irrevocably to demand and receive, sue for, and recover from the United States, or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority, all and singular the premises, right, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and fold, and now withheld and detained from by the United States or the State of Pennsylvania

with power full attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or his - substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
