Before me the Judge one of Commissioners of the Justice
in and for said County, personally came William
Standerford, and on his solemn oath, that he
Standerford of Jefferson County, then Cumberland but now
Mylin County, Middle Tennessee, in the State of

England, was enlisted under Captain Cox in the month
of January, or February, in the year one thousand seven
hundred and seventy seven — and this Standerford
further deposes that he this Standerford was in the
State, in the Months of November, and December, the
same year, and when he was near White Mountain

he was informed that his Brother Daniel Standerford
was then within one Mile of that place, and expected
to have seen him next day, but the army moved in
the night which prevented his seeing him — and
after he this Standerford came home, his Brother John
Standerford went to live a few in the Mills, and he
told his Brother John he should inquire after Daniel
and when John returned, he said, he had inquired after
him but could not find him, he said he went to
a Sergeant of the Company to which he belonged and

the Sergeant told him he was dead and this Standerford
further deposes that

Standerford and published this last day of March 1802
